Firstly the village hall has a new hat! The re-thatching of the roof finished in early spring, so we are now soundly dry for many years to come. Many thanks to the thatching team, lead by Dave Trant from Hennock, who have all done a splendid job in creating a typical Devon styled thatched roof for us all to admire. It sits pretty on our listed hall, originally the village tithe barn. Our grateful thanks go to Mr. & Mrs. Ward at The Old Vicarage for their support in kindly allowing us access to thatch the rear of the hall roof.

The roof lights at the rear of the hall, which have been leaking for some time, have all been replaced. The new lights will also let in far more daylight into the hall room.

Sadly our annual Village Fayre was cancelled, like so many other similar events and now some of the events going forward are put on hold for this year - Apple Day at West Hele, Halloween Children's party and the Christmas Fair in November, unless we can come up with some new ideas on how to hold these events in revised settings in line with Government Guide lines on social distancing, numbers etc. If the Government revises these guide lines in due course, then these events could be reconsidered in the hall.


